Destination Swindon

Majority of delegates wanted more information and welcomed the presentation.

Comments included:

- “Good idea – but difficult to plan ahead given the budget pressures”
- “Looking forward to the ‘putting it into practice part”
- “More involvement from 3rd Sector needed”
- “I like the idea of Destination Swindon – lets get on with the job”.
