## Financial Environment

- Public efficiency savings requirement
- £20bn NHS for reinvestment in quality & outcomes
- Broad planning assumption: *flat cash & negative tariff*
- £42.1m<sup>(net)</sup> released: whole-system/care-model approach
- Key financial risks:
  - Impact of CSR on NHS & Local partners
  - Managing impact of population growth

## Quick Wins

- Implementation of a 24/7 integrated urgent care centre, with 24/7 virtual hub (underpinned by CMS).
  - *Trialled through the summer, full implementation Oct 10.*
- Implementation of 300 virtual beds enhanced with telehealth
  - *(GPs now refer to as ‘community beds’)*
  - *480 people identified as meeting virtual bed criteria.*
  - *55 beds open now, 300 by March 2011.*
- Implementation intermediate care and re-ablement service.
  - *Integrated health and social care approach*
- Social care overnight service implemented July 2010
- Integration of Mental Health Older Peoples Community Teams with community health and social care teams

## Added benefits of integrated working

- Integrated management of savings plans
- Easy access to social care stops admissions
  - *(850 last year)*
- Easy access to all services for GPs: One phone call
  - *Releases more GP time to see patients*
- Housing manage installations/maintenance of telehealth
- Leisure services run COPD/Heart failure rehab
- Care Home Contracts Team support medicines mngnt.

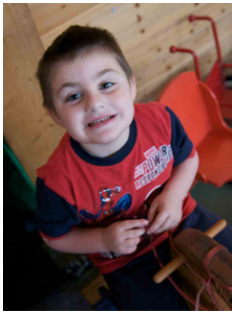
